RFP: 2018-0003 – Exterior Lighting Redesign – High Rise Sites

Re: **Proposed design of exterior lighting fixtures to enhance the safety/security and lighting aesthetic, as well as to reduce hydro consumption on 15 high rise sites within the city of London, ON**

To Whom It May Concern,

The London and Middlesex Housing Corporation is considering the replacement of all exterior light fixtures at their multi-residential apartment buildings. The new fixtures must provide a reduction in energy consumption while enhancing the site appearance and safety.

We invite your organization to submit a fee proposal to provide:

Provide a pre-retrofit light level analysis of the existing sites showing the types and locations of all existing fixtures and light levels for each fixture and a new design drawing on adding exterior lighting and cameras to increase the safety/security as well as the aesthetic of the sites.

The design work from the award of this RFP will be used to form the tender documents for the Exterior Lighting Redesign Project.

## SECTION "A" – INVESTIGATION / ANALYSIS / DESIGN

1. Primary focus of this Section A will be to determine the changes required.
2. Review existing plans, verify conditions through site visit, and conduct all other related investigations. Where existing plans are not sufficiently legible, accurate or unavailable, make all additional measurements and investigations necessary.
3. Hold discussions with all those having authority over the operation of the building, including Housing Corporation staff and/or assigned Project Manager, to assist in determining the needs of that particular site.
4. Obtain the services of other specialists as required to design changes to meet all Municipal and Provincial bylaws and building codes, electrical codes and manufacturers' requirements. Prepare drawings, PDF Adobe format, and specifications in Word to reflect these changes and requirements. Submit Word files to Owner.
6. All work shall include the cost of all items and equipment incidental to the inspection, analysis and design.
7. All fixtures, bulbs and related items must be manufactured in North America
8. All fixtures, bulbs and related electrical equipment must be warranted for a minimum of 10 years from day of installation.
9. Provide a delivery date indicating the number of days from the date of approval.
10. Provide confirmation of product availability after the date of installation.
11. Provide a rendering of design work done on previous projects or rendering of an LMHC site.
12. Provide documentation of any relevant certifications such CPTED (Crime prevention through environmental design)
